Trail Etiquette

- Be safety conscious; use trails at your own risk.
- No unauthorized motorized vehicles.
- Stay on trails, avoid short cuts.
- Prepare for weather with food, clothing and water.
- Dogs should be on leash or on voice command at all times.
- It's wise to carry a phone in case of emergencies.

Preserve Etiquette

- Preserve closes at dusk.
- Carry out what you have carried in.
- Preserve the past—leave cultural artifacts where you find them.
- No campfires, no camping.
- Respect wildlife, observe quietly from a distance.
- Let nature's sounds prevail. Avoid loud voices and noises.
- No blasting allowed. Rock hounding permitted.

Snow Shoers Welcome.




